

Pool Rules

1. Running, pushing, horseplay or any other behavior that puts any patron or staff at risk will not be tolerated.
2. All members and guests must check in at the front desk.
3. Smoking IS NOT allowed within the pool gate.
4. No glass containers.
5. Proper swimming attire should be worn at all times this includes No jeans & No overly revealing swim suits.(This is a family friendly pool)
6. Profanity or any other inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
7. Adult swim is for people 18 and older only. Children 4 and younger are allowed ONLY IF their parent is within arm's reach at all times.
8. Rafts, tubes, and pool games are only permitted when safe conditions exist, as determined by life guards.
9. Children must be 10 years old & pass a swim test to come to the pool alone.

Pool SEVERE WEATHER SAFETY: RULES AND PROCEDURES*

In case of thunder:

Pool will be cleared for 30 minutes after thunder is heard. The clock will be restarted after every time thunder is heard.

In case of lightning:

Pool will be cleared for 30 minutes after lightning is detected. The clock will be restarted for every consecutive lightning strike detected. Patrons will be cleared from the pool deck during this time.

In case of a Tornado Watch:

Patrons will be informed of the watch and asked to take necessary precautions.

In case of a Tornado Warning:

Remaining patrons will be asked to leave or to seek shelter as directed by the guards.

Rain:

Patrons are allowed to swim in the rain, unless the rain begins to interfere with pool visibility. Then, guards may close areas of the pool or clear all swimmers as they see fit.

Wind:

If the wind causes visibility issues in the pool, guards may close certain areas of the pool or clear all swimmers as they see fit.
